



AWWA Bonanza Program Terms and Conditions

General Rules

To be eligible to compete for Bonanza Program prize monies that are distributed each year at the U.S. Nationals, horses must have a completed Arabian Working Western Alliance (AWWA) Bonanza Program entry form for that particular competition year on file with the AWWA and paid the entry fee of \$150 per class.

Specific AHA U.S. National classes that are Bonanza-designated are determined by the AWWA Board of Directors. The list of classes is available on the AWWA website at www.ArabianWorkingWestern.com.

Placings for payouts are based on the final total scores earned from the AHA National judge(s) during the U.S. Nationals championship classes.

The AWWA Executive Committee, at its option, shall have the authority to handle any disputes involved in the AWWA Bonanza Program and shall have final decision-making on all dispute resolutions.

Horses must be entered properly in the corresponding U.S. Nationals class as administered by the Arabian Horse Association (AHA) in order to be eligible for Bonanza payout monies.

There is no sire or dam nomination fee to enroll in the Bonanza Program. All horses properly registered with AHA or CAHA are eligible to enroll for the Bonanza monies.

Nominated AWWA Stallions

A list of nominated AWWA stallions is on the website. Any horse competing for Bonanza money who is sired by a nominated stallion is eligible to win additional prize money. If the highest scoring horse in any of the Bonanza-designated classes is sired by an AWWA nominated stallion, that horse earns a bonus check of \$500.

Competition Entry

Owners may enter any number of horses to the Bonanza Program. Each horse needs to be entered each year for each class in which they wish to compete.

The cost of enrolling in each Bonanza class is \$150 per class. An office fee of \$25 is due for each horse.

The completed entry form and full payment must be sent to address on the AWWA entry form prior to closing date of September 15th as established by AWWA Board of Directors.

No late entry forms will be accepted.

Payback Distribution

Placings for payouts are based on the final total scores earned from the AHA National judge(s) during the U.S. Nationals championship classes.

\$100 from each class entry fee is placed in a fund specific to that class. The AWWA will add \$500 to the amount for the total prize money available for distribution.

Prize money is distributed according to the Bonanza Payback Schedule found at the website: www.ArabianWorkingWestern.com.

Payback checks are sent to the recorded owner of the horse as shown on the horse's official registration papers.

In order to receive any prize money, winning horse owners must send the AWWA a completed W9 form within sixty days of the completion of U.S. Nationals. If the W9 form is not received within that time, no payback will be issued. Prize money checks must be cashed within 90 days of the date issued. Checks will be considered void after that time.
